## Sheridan Figure Skating Club Learn to Skate USA Program 2022/2023 Season Registration Information

Skating programs are designed for children in grades K-12 and adults. The entire focus is on skating skills and having fun. Each developmental level is comprised of various skating components. The progression is structured for the skill development of all participants. We offer instruction to participants interested in introductory skating, recreational skating and competitive figure skating. The skating programs include:

**Snowplow Sam** is for ages 3 to 5 years old. It is designed to help children develop the preliminary coordination and strength necessary to maneuver on skates without the parent.

Basic 1-6 (K-12) & Adult program: The mission of the Basic Skills Learn to Skate Program is to provide a goal-oriented program that encourages ice skating at all levels and to enhance the quality of skating skills at these levels. Classes follow a progression introducing new skills once the previous skills have been mastered. Skills in Basic 1-3 are designed to build students confidence on the ice and familiarize them with the basics of skating. Skills include: forward skating, gliding, stopping, backward skating and swizzles. Basic 4-6 introduce more complex skills like forward and backward crossovers and introductory figure skating elements like spins and jumps. Students must pass all of the skills in each level to progress to the next level. Adult classes offer skaters a chance to improve their skating skills while improving balance and strength.

**Beginning Figure Skating:** This class is open to skaters who have mastered forward crossovers. Skaters will have the opportunity to learn some additional skills with the intention of moving toward competitive figure skating. The focus will be on body position, edge correctness, skill development and choreography.

<u>Ice Show</u>: The Ice Show Session is for skaters of all ages and abilities to showcase their skating skills. Skaters will be grouped by ability and learn a choreographed group routine to perform in the spring Ice Show. It is a great introduction to skating in front of a crowd and an opportunity for family and friends to cheer on their skater. Practice for the Ice Show will be twice a week on **Tuesday AND Thursday** in order to prepare for the show. Please be sure the skaters can attend all of the practices.
