PRIZES

Qualifying green rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH/PACH rosettes and MACH/PACH bars will be awarded to teams achieving their MACH/PACH title. Placement trophies will be Stainless Steel Fruit Infusers.

Master/Excellent Standard
Open Standard
Novice Standard
Time 2 Beat
Master/Excellent Jumpers With Weaves
Open Jumpers With Weaves
Novice Jumpers With Weaves

Jump Heights will be High to Low

Walk-throughs start at 7:40 am. Judging starts at 8:00 am.

Final running orders will be emailed with your confirmation letters.

Judging will include both the Regular and Preferred Classes.

Preferred Classes will run together with corresponding Regular classes with the Preferred Classes running last (if practicable) within each jump height.

Complete descriptions and qualifications for each class are published in The AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Please note that a dog may be entered in the Regular Classes and in the Preferred Classes at this set of trials, as explained in the following:

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes within the same Trial. Entering Multiple Jump Heights within the same Trial Day.

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes are allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in a Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, NO Double Q shall be earned toward either MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires Standard Agility & JWW be either both Regular or both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20 inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial day, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully compete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. FNG is not per-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in Time 2 Beat and FAST Classes. Participation in FEO is optional and is non-qualifying.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles used will be those as defined in The AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

JUMP HEIGHT POLICY

Please check the appropriate box on the entry form indicating if the dog needs to be measured.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be measured if necessary and to enter the proper height division.

NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

The Trial Secretary must receive move-ups by 6pm EST on the Monday before the trial. Move-ups may be emailed to Slavinspectra@gmail.com.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trials. All entries must be made on an Official AKC Entry Form or copy and must include the agreements on the reverse. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Full and immediately negotiable funds must accompany each entry.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Puppies under 4 months are strictly prohibited from the grounds.

BE A RESPONSIBLE dog owner and exhibitor. Pick up after your dog on the grounds and at your hotel site and encourage others to do the same.

<u>RV</u> World Equestrian Center RV Park It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

Since Bitches in season and injured dogs are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5 per run of the daily entry fee for bitches in season or injured dogs unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund by the day of the trial. Documentation by a veterinarian is required.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Pinch collars, electric and dummy collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. Training/chain collars are 'choke' collars and they are allowed on the grounds.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all Flat-Coated Retrievers 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are Flat-Coated Retrievers that have obtained a PAL or ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal & external parasites, and communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes <u>must</u> compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
