

Service To Girls Award

Purpose: This award is given on an annual basis to leaders that fulfill the progressing requirements below. The color of the pins change each year with a maximum of seven pins awarded.



1. Be a registered troop leader (01), assistant troop leader (02) or service team member (11)



2. Attend or be represented at 75% of SU Leader meetings

3. Attend a Service Unit activity



4. Participate on a Service Unit activity committee

5. Chair a Service Unit activity committee

6. Attend GSNENY or other enrichment training ie: Outdoor Education Day, GSNENY Girl Scout University

7. Hold a service unit team position or be a delegate for your Service Unit

8. Volunteer on a GSNENY council committee or event

Green pin—Requirement 1 and 2

Blue Pin—Requirement 1, 2, 3

Purple Pin—Requirement 1, 2, 3, 4

Pink Pin—Requirement 1, 2, 3, 4, 5

Red Pin—Requirement 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

Orange Pin—Requirement 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7

Yellow Pin—Requirement 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8

Approval process: Leaders are tracked by their Service Unit Managers and those that fulfill the requirements are awarded the corresponding pin by GSNENY.
