

Count & Go's

COUNT & GO'S/COOKIE DELIVERY

Count & Go's are when troops pick up their Initial Order (rounded to the nearest full case). Troops will be able to sign up for their date, time, and location in eBudde once they submit their Initial Order. If a Count & Go spot is not picked by the troop by the deadline, Council will assign a pickup to the troop. Bring a second person to count at a Count & Go and enough vehicles to fit the entire order.

The Day of Your Cookie Pick-up:

- Each troop must have two people- a counter and a driver. Counters must get out of the vehicle.
- Please arrive at your Count & Go delivery site 10-15 minutes early. Check in with Council Staff.
- Bubble Sheets: Leaders must print and bring 2 copies of the bubble sheet to the Count & Go.
- Troops must have a vehicle or vehicles large enough to take the entire troop cookie order (troops cannot pick up partial orders).
- Trucking agents are only allowed to load one variety of cookie at a time – if volunteers feel the agents are loading too quickly to count cookies, they must let the agents know to slow down.
- Counter must count all cases being loaded into all vehicles and indicate number received on troop bubble sheet. The counter turns in the troop bubble sheet to the GSNENY Staff at the end of the Count & Go delivery location.
- If you are unsure of the number of cases received, you must re-count all cases prior to leaving the Count & Go location.

Once the vehicle(s) have left the Count & Go location, all counts are final.
