



St. Mary's Sunshine Center **Summer Camp Program 2022**



St. Mary's Sunshine Center will be offering themed camps filled with fun and adventure. Each session is full of hands-on activities that focus on different interests. Some weeks may have field trips and/or guest speakers unfortunately, this is unknown at this time.

Week 1: 6/20-6/24 Sunshine Olympics- Campers will discover that many different countries take part in the Olympics. They will learn about the various countries, sports, and Olympic events. The children will create their own Olympic events for everyone to try.

Week 2: 6/27-7/1 Craft-tastic- Campers will tap into their creative side! Utilizing various mediums, we will create many hand-crafted treasures.

Week 3: 7/5-7/8 All Around Maryland- Campers will explore Maryland, including life in The Chesapeake Bay and area wetlands. We will create activities using Maryland symbols and discover local tales and history of our state.

Week 4: 7/11-7/15 Survival of the Fittest- Animals survive in different types of habitats. They face a variety of challenges from predators, extreme weather, and finding adequate food and water. Campers will look at how animals have adapted for survival. Campers will test their own survival skills this week.

Week 5: 7/18-7/22 Reduce, Reuse and Upcycle- Campers will use a variety of recycled materials to make fun new creation. Camper will learn about the amount of waste each person produces and discuss way we can make a difference.

Week 6: 7/25-7/29 A World of Water- Campers will explore the properties of water hands-on. They will experiment with water and enjoy lots of fun activities learning all water can do for us. Campers will explore streams, create their own and talk about the effects of water on different surfaces.

Week 7: 8/1-8/5 Let's Fuel Up the Fun! - Food is the fuel of life. Campers will make flavorful and nutritious snacks to keep them fueled up and ready to go. Campers will express their creativity making edible food art.

Week 8: 8/8-8/12 The Magic of Science- Campers will explore science through hands-on activities. We will investigate everything from volcanos to rainbows and create some of our own. Is it magic or science? Campers will use the scientific method and test their own hypothesis to find out. Tuesday the 9th The Singing Scientist visits Sunshine.

Week 9: 8/15-8/19 How the West was fun! – Campers will be introduced to the US expansion out west and what life was like in the old west. Camper will pan for "gold", weave a basket and create feather/bead accessories. We have many more fun hands-on activities this week.

Sunshine summer camps are for ages 5 through 12. Campers will be placed in groups according to age and/or ability. Camp costs include camp and daycare between 6:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. A \$15.00 registration fee is due at time of registration for new Campers. Registration fee does not apply to current Sunshine students. There is an \$80.00 deposit per week due at time of registration for all campers.
