Chaperones

Space for 10 Parent Chaperones on a first-come, first-served basis

Chaperones must have DCSD Level 3 security volunteer status.

Chaperones will pay a reduced cost of the trip

Chaperones will be responsible for evening room checks and morning wake-up calls for 2 or 3 student rooms (4 students per room)

Chaperones will be responsible for physical check-in with a student group (Approximately 10 students) while in the parks

Chaperones will help monitor behavior and head-counts on the buses during travel
