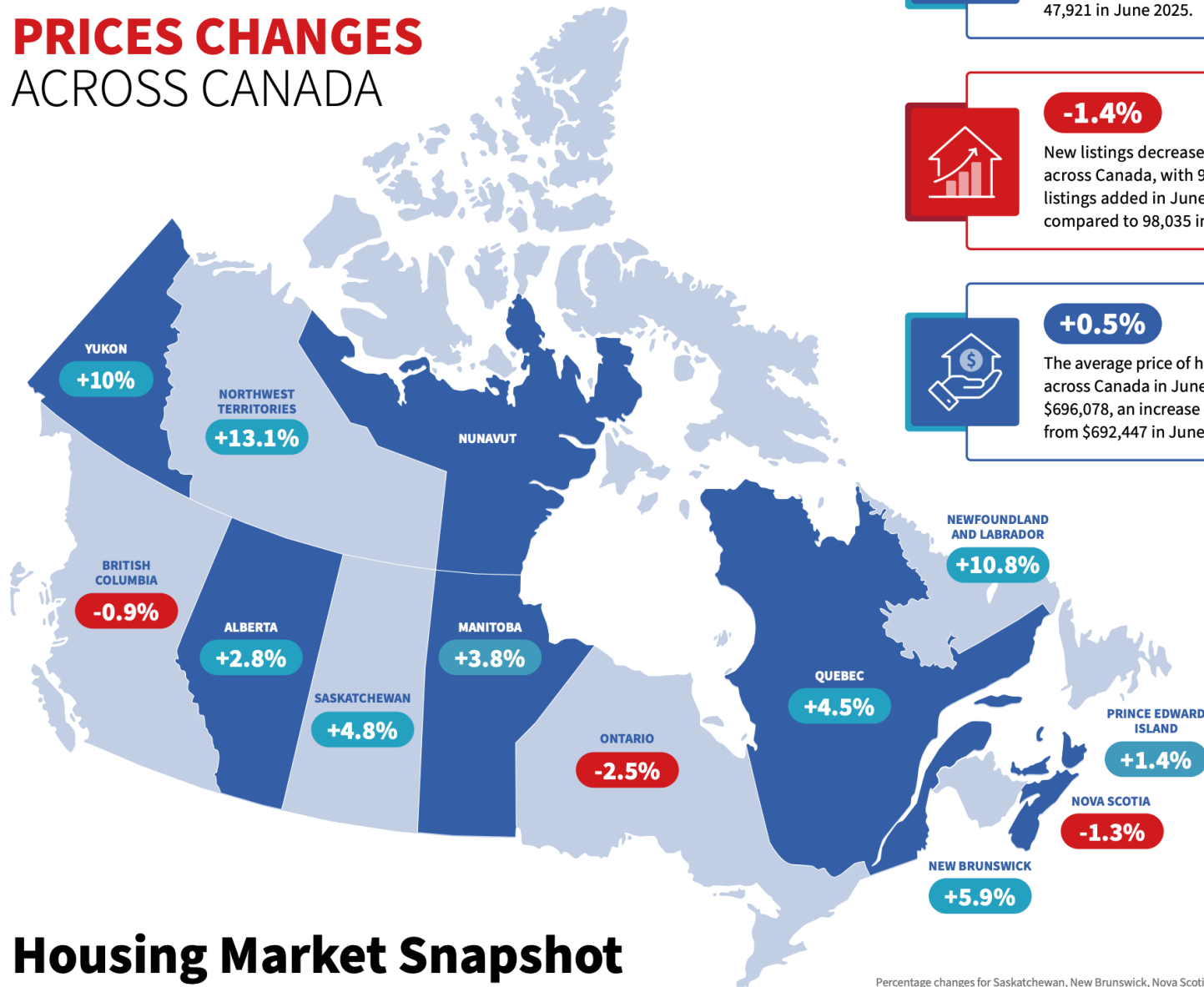


PRICES CHANGES ACROSS CANADA



+0.9%

Home sales increased by 0.9% across Canada, with 48,342 units sold in June 2026, compared to 47,921 in June 2025.



-1.4%

New listings decreased by 1.4% across Canada, with 96,640 new listings added in June 2026, compared to 98,035 in June 2025.



+0.5%

The average price of homes sold across Canada in June 2026 was \$696,078, an increase of 0.5% from \$692,447 in June 2025.

While the province of Quebec uses the weighted residential average price, provided by QPAREB. All other provinces and territories are residential average price changes for their specific region.
