Who is Eligible to Submit to a Funding Opportunity?

According to Grants.gov, there are many groups of organizations that are eligible to apply for government funding opportunities. Typically, most applicant organizations fall into the following categories:

- Government Organizations
- Education Organizations
- Public Housing Organizations
- Nonprofit Organizations having 501 (c)(3) status per the IRS code
- For profit Organizations (other than small businesses)
- Individuals (only funding opportunities that are open to individuals)

Monies awarded as a grant are meant to meet particular needs and is not required to be repaid. However, strict guidelines imposed by government and foundation grant-makers must be adhered to throughout the grant seeking and award process. Grants also cater to some of the basic needs of the impoverished, including food, shelter, and education by assisting nonprofits with their program service offerings.
