Options for Coursework:

a. On Demand:

Start the On-Demand course today! There is no need to wait for materials to ship. The course is entirely online and includes printable reading materials. Each chapter is set up with a printable PDF containing chapter content along with a video, true/false, vocabulary, case studies and quiz section to measure your comprehension. After completing the required assignments, you will take a practice exam for course completion. Upon completion of the course, the student prints their Certificate of Completion, and information is updated in their WRA® file. Students will have *six months from* date of registration to complete the program. All on demand sessions and modules must be completed to receive credit for this course, in addition to the final practice exam.

b. Online:

The online pre-license course offers students a combination of reading chapters from the course book, and going online to watch short educational videos, and complete chapter exercises and assignments. While in the program, you will have access to a student bulletin board, where you can post questions and interact with other students. Upon registration, you will receive 3 course books within 5-7 business days, which will be available for pick-up at the Innovations Cafe. After completing all online chapter quizzes, the student will be prompted to take the final practice exam. Completion of the exam will generate the student's Certificate of Completion and update the student's WRA® file. Students will have *six months from* date of registration to complete the program. Course books include: Pre-License Online Course Book, Pre -Exam Review, and your Student Guide. All online quizzes and modules *must* be completed to receive credit for this course, in addition to the final practice exam.

Enrollment Details

Requirements: Computer with Broadband connection, Adobe Acrobat, Windows Media Player, or QuickTime 6.0, printing access.

Registration: To register, complete the designated Google form ([Click here](#)). Your name, address, home phone number, and email will be required to complete registration. Payment will be due at the time of registration, in the form of a cashier's check, cash, personal checks order will be on hold until check has cleared. We also use PayPal for debit, or credit cards.

Once Registered: On Demand Option

Once you are On Demand coursework is ordered by our company, you will receive an email from our staff with detailed instructions for On Demand access & a quick link. The quick link provided will direct you to the WRA® website, where you will need to create your own WRA® account (using the “create account” link on the webpage). Your account will need to match the name and email provided at the time of registration, and your ID Number – found on the original WRA® email you receive. From here, your coursework will begin. You will be provided with printable PDFs to help guide you through the On-Demand course. Upon completion of all modules, you will receive instructions for taking your final practice exam. Once the final practice exam is completed, you will receive your Certificate of Completion, and move forward with signing up for the state licensure exam.

Once Registered: Online Option

Within 5 business days from registration, your course books will be available for pick up at the Innovations office – our staff will contact you via phone and email as soon as they arrive. Upon receiving your coursework, you will find all instructions for beginning your course in your provided Student Guide. Upon logging into your portal, you will find a course outline which will explain, in detail, how to navigate your online modules. After completing all chapter quizzes and activities, you will take a final practice exam. Once the final practice exam is completed, you will receive your Certificate of Completion, and move forward with signing up for the state licensure exam.

**** Please note you will need to provide a valid license or ID when picking up materials. If someone is picking up on your behalf, you will need to make prior arrangements with our staff, and they will need to provide a valid license or ID upon arrival. There are no exceptions & materials will not be distributed without proof of identity.***

Shipping: If you are participating in the Online Coursework Program, your materials will be shipped to our office. Our staff will contact you via phone and email as soon as they are available for pick up. **Please allow a maximum of 5-7 business days for shipping. If you have not been contacted after this timeframe, please contact Jamie Warosh @ Innovations at (262) 652-2200.**

What is a Course Certificate of Completion? Upon completion of all modules –On Demand or Online – you will be prompted to complete your final practice exam. Once the exam has been taken, your Course Certificate of Completion will be generated and delivered to you. At this time, it is best to touch base with our office and we will provide you with guidance in signing up for the state licensure exam. Your Certificate of Completion is not required to take the licensing exam; however, it will need to be provided to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS) upon passing the licensing exam and applying for licensure.

Wisconsin State Licensing Exam: Additional fees for the state exam are at the expense of the student, and *not* included in the purchase of the course.
