Adams, Kennedy, Pierce, Coolidge — 4–5 Days • All legs ≤ 4 hours

Day 1 – Arrive Boston (Late Morning) & Quincy

Overnight: Boston Back Bay

Arrive late morning; spend the afternoon at Adams NHP. Enjoy dinner in Back Bay or Fenway area.

Day 2 – JFK & Lexington/Concord MA

Overnight: Concord, MA

Morning JFK sites, afternoon Revolutionary War sites. Overnight in Concord, MA for a relaxed start to Day 3.

Day 3 – Concord, NH & Franklin Pierce

Overnight: Concord, NH

Drive from Concord, MA to Concord, NH (~1.5 hrs). Visit Pierce Manse in the afternoon.

Day 4 – Vermont & Calvin Coolidge

Overnight: Woodstock or Ludlow, VT

Drive from Concord, NH to Plymouth Notch (~2.5 hrs). Afternoon at Coolidge site, then overnight nearby.

Day 5 – Optional Coolidge Library & Return Travel

Overnight: Return travel

Morning drive to Northampton (~2 hrs from Plymouth Notch) for optional Coolidge Library, then onward to your departure hub.

Driving & Planning Notes

- All legs ≤ 4 hours; most are 1–3 hours.
- Overnight in Concord, MA on Day 2 for a smoother itinerary.
- Optional Coolidge Library on Day 5 adds presidential depth in Western Massachusetts.
- Reserve timed-entry tickets for Adams NHP and JFK sites in peak months.
- Foliage season (late Sep–Oct) is popular; book early.
