TOUR OF DUTY NORTHEAST SHRINE ASSOCIATION FIELD DAYS PARADE SATURDAY, AUGUST 22, 2026

I am pleased to announce for Illustrious Roger T. Gardiner that Aleppo Shriners parade units will participate in the Northeast Shrine Association Field Days Parade on Saturday, August 22, 2026. As Chief of Staff, it gives me great pleasure to provide the following details and instructions.

PLEASE NOTE THE ALEPPO PARKING LOCATIONS ON PARADE DAY:

Parking in front of Aleppo Shriners Auditorium (nobles on hired bus service to Hyannis).

Parking at the Margaritaville Resort (nobles with reservations at NSA).

Parade Assembly Area: Old Colony Road at South Street Hyannis (Barnstable), MA

- 10:15 AM** **Nobles traveling from Aleppo Shriners Auditorium** to the assembly area by hired bus service will park in front of Aleppo Shriners Auditorium, for boarding the bus. Parading nobles are **ENCOURAGED** to travel using the hired bus service from Aleppo vs. personal transportation to the Cape, if possible.
Unit Captains should make group reservations electronically for members.
- 10:30 AM** The Aleppo-hired bus service will leave promptly to proceed to Hyannis to the parade assembly area.
- 11:30 AM** **Nobles at the NSA Hotels** assigned to unload vehicles from the tractor trailers before the start of the parade will meet Mark Norton, Transportation Director in front of the Margaritaville Resort, and will proceed to the parade assembly area for unloading and parade assembly.
ONLY Aleppo Parade Vehicles will participate in the parade (no Trucks).
- 12:00 PM** The Aleppo Bus / Vans at NSA will run from the hotel to the parade area from 12:00 PM to 1:30 PM for nobles and their family members attending the parade. All Units transporting their own equipment and Nobles traveling by private vehicle will proceed to the assembly area to unload their vehicles prior to parade assembly. After off-loading, all vehicles will leave the assembly area and proceed to the end of the parade route – proposed parking is being arranged at - T.B.D. – either the former Cape Cod Conference Center property, Scudder Avenue; -or- Sturgis Charter School, West Main Street.
- 12:30 PM** Parade Assembly.
- 2:00 PM** Parade step-off – rain or shine.
- 4:00 PM** Nobles returning to Aleppo will load the Aleppo-hired bus service for immediate (estimate) departure back to Wilmington. The bus / vans on the Cape will shuttle nobles and Ladies back to the hotels.

FAQs from Shrine Temples:

Will there be a place to park trailers with Mini Cars, etc. for Nobles staying at Margaritaville?

Overnight parking for tractor trailers and pickups with cargo trailers has been arranged at the Barnstable Department of Public Works 382 Bearses Way at the intersection with MA Route 28. This location is 1 mile from the Margaritaville Resort.

The designated parade assembly area; Old Colony Road and South Street, Barnstable.

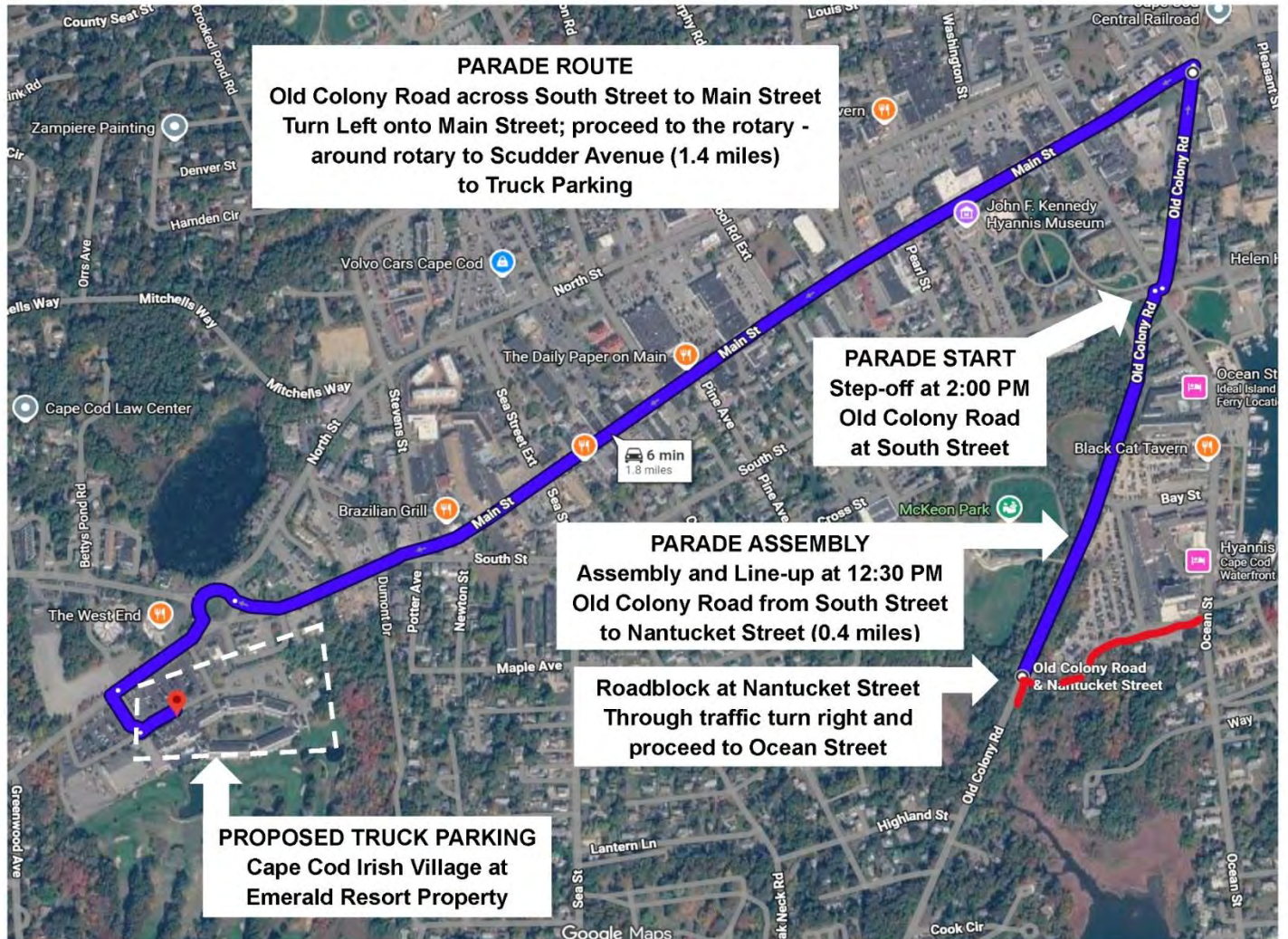
What time is Step Off?

Travel From Margaritaville Resort to Parade Assembly Area (10 minutes without traffic):

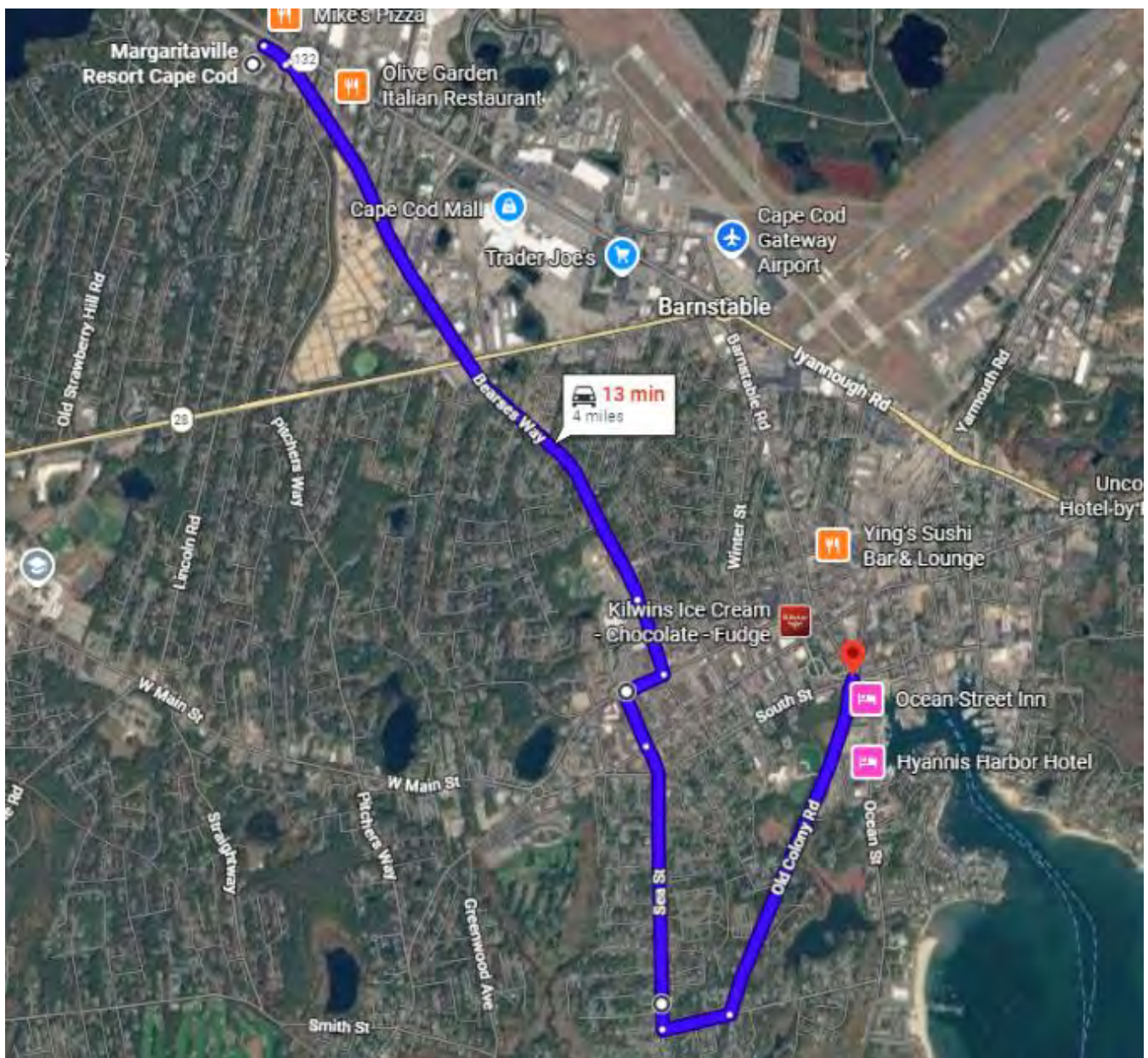
Exit the parking lot at Margaritaville Resort, turning right onto Bearses Way (1.6 mile)

At the traffic circle, continue straight onto Bassett Lane (0.2 mile)

Turn right onto North Street (0.1 mile); then turn left onto Sea Street Extension (0.1 mile); continue through lights onto Sea Street (0.7 mile)

Turn left onto Gosnold Street (0.2 mile); then turn left onto Old Colony Road (0.9 mile)

Assembly on Old Colony Road between Nantucket Street (end) and South Street (beginning).





Travel from Parade Assembly Area to End of Parade & Parking (8 minutes without traffic):

Follow Old Colony Road and turn left onto Main Street (0.1 mile), right onto Barnstable Road (338 ft.), then left onto North Street (0.2 mile)

Follow North Street to the traffic circle (1 mile)

For parking area(s) [T.B.D.]:

[Sturgis School] – enter traffic circle, take 2nd exit onto West Main Street, Sturgis School on left after CC Melody Tent

[CC Conference Center] – enter traffic circle, take 3rd exit onto Scudder Avenue, parking on right.





Travel From Parade End Parking Area(s) to Assembly Area (7 minutes without traffic):

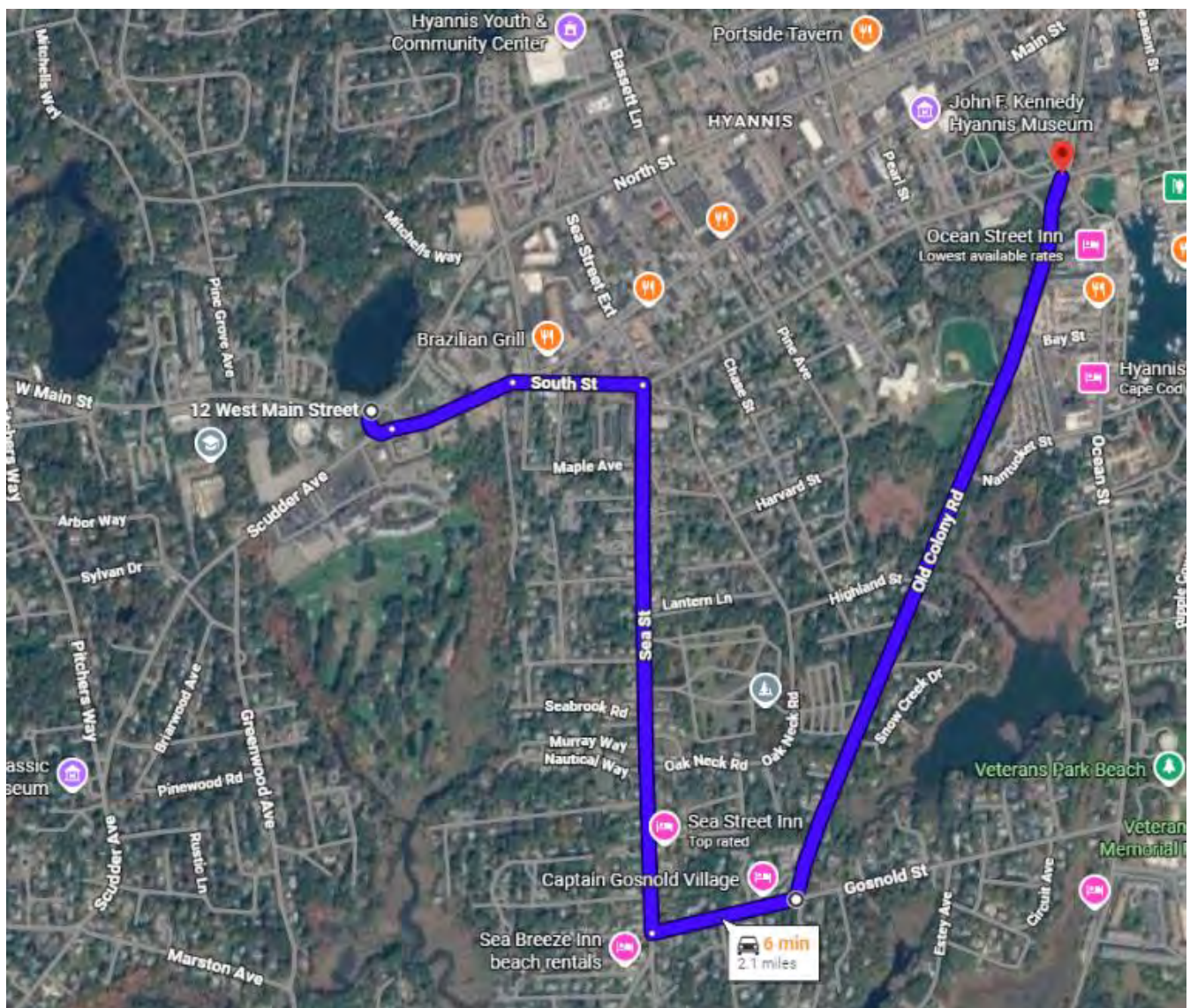
From Parking Area(s) at Cape Cod Conference Center property, Scudder Avenue; -or- Sturgis Charter School, West Main Street

From Scudder Avenue -or- West Main Street -- proceed to the West End Traffic Circle and exit right onto Main Street which becomes South Street (0.2 mile)

At lights, turn right onto Sea Street (0.7 mile)

Turn left onto Gosnold Street (0.2 mile); then turn left onto Old Colony Road (0.9 mile)

Assembly on Old Colony Road between Nantucket Street (end) and South Street (beginning).





Map to Overnight Truck Parking Area near Margaritaville Report:

Barnstable Public Works Department 382 Falmouth Road, Hyannis

1 Mile from Margaritaville Resort – turn right from parking lot and follow Bearses Way 1 mile – lot on the right at the intersection with MA-Route 28 (Falmouth Road)
