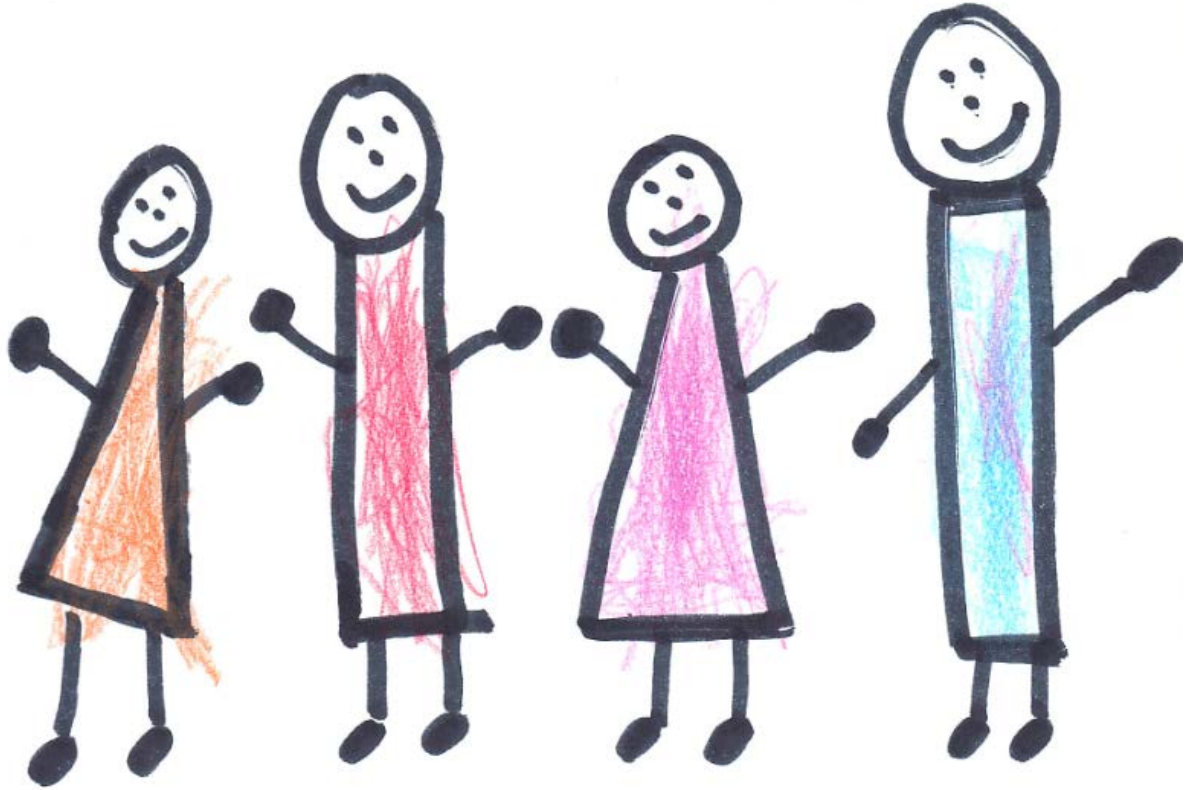

I love my home

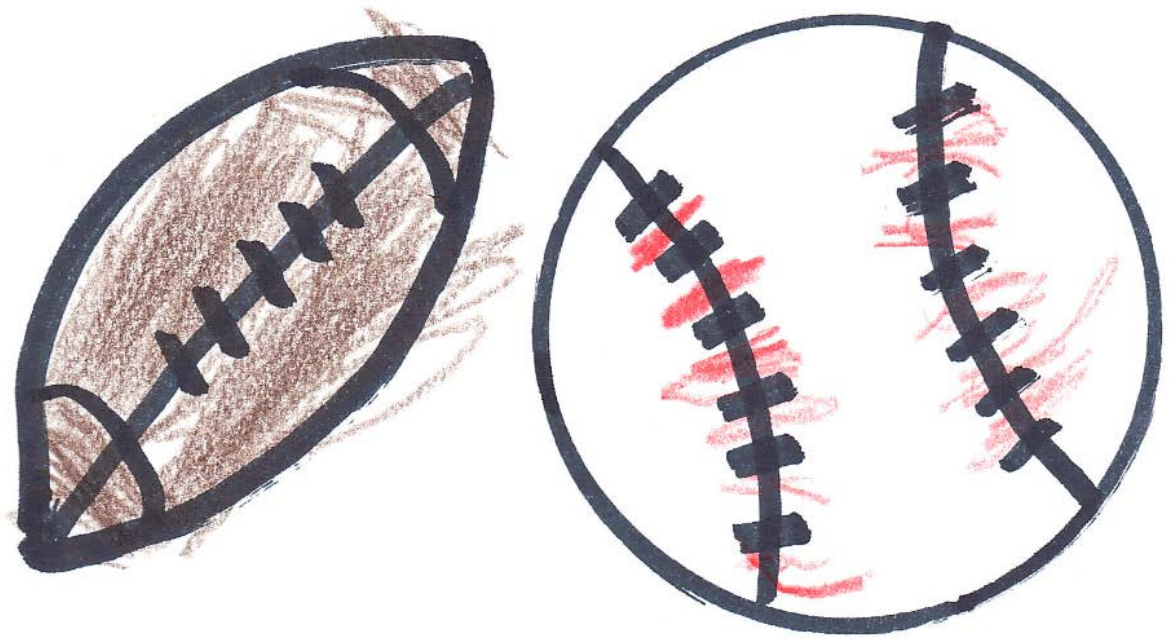
I really do

Some creative things to do



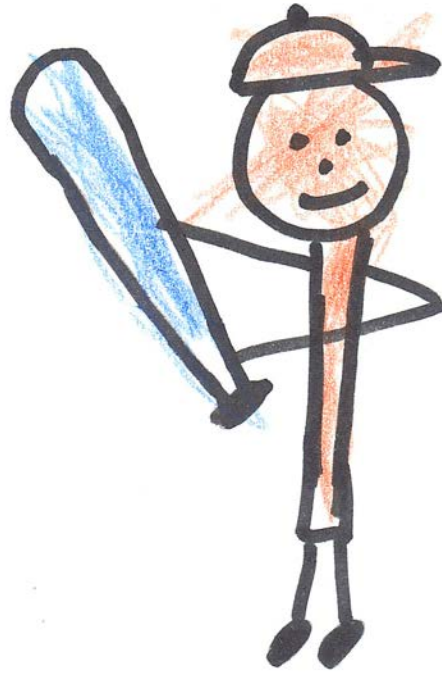
Like exploring trees and animals
And tasting vegetables I grew.



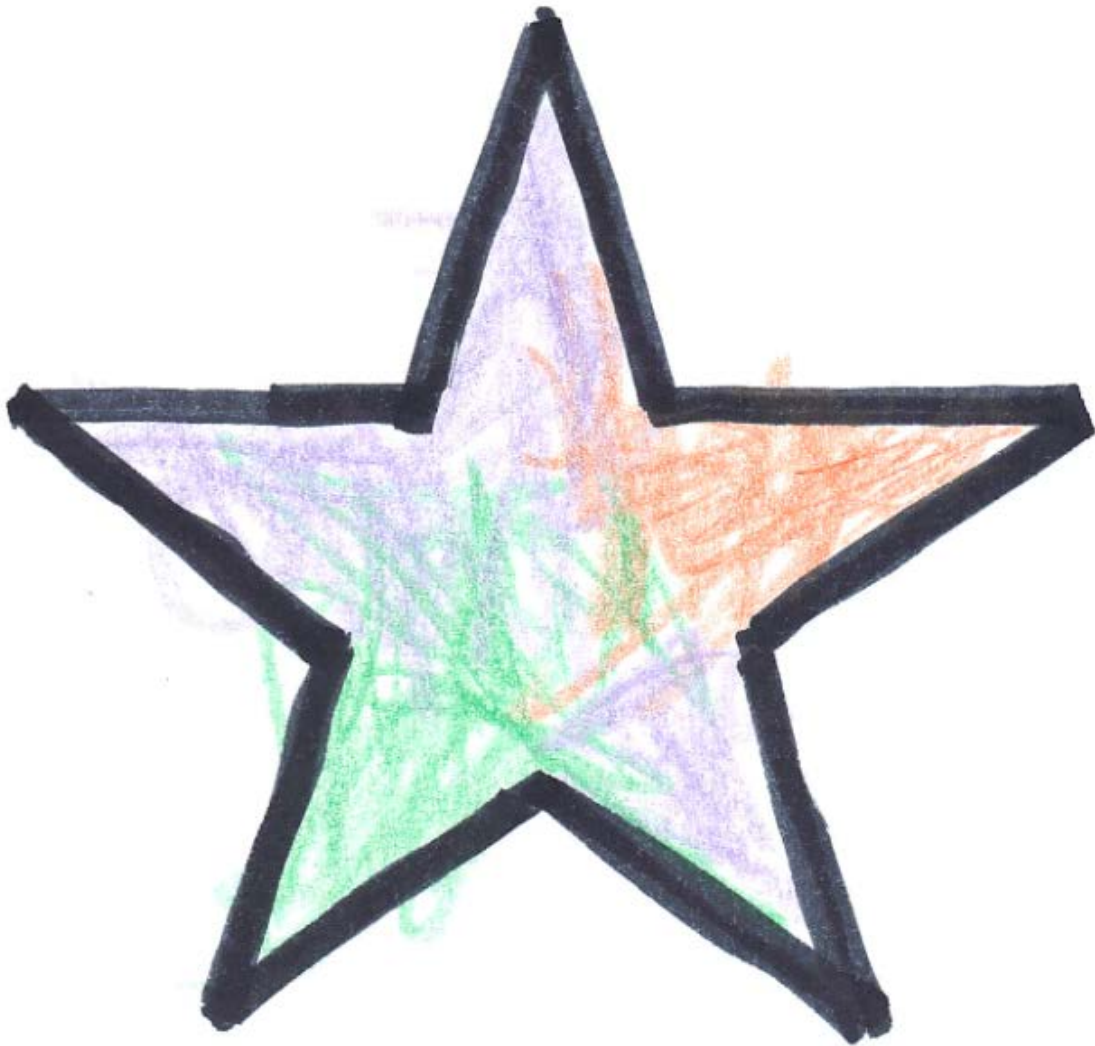
I'm reading more books
