The Montgomery Amateur Radio Club is offering a ham radio licensing class in January 2027.

The class will meet on eight consecutive Thursday evenings January 7 – February 25, 2027, 6:00 PM – 8:30 PM. The class will be held at Frazer Church, 6000 Atlanta Highway, Montgomery, AL 36117.

Enrollment is now open. Early enrollment is encouraged.

The fee for the class is \$ 40.00 which includes the ARRL Technician License Class Study Guide. This course will prepare you to take the Technician Class license exam which will be administered on Thursday, March 4, 2027, starting at 6:00 PM. If you pass you will get an email from the FCC and you will need to pay a \$ 35.00 fee to get your license.

The Technician Class license is the entry level license into amateur radio. It gives you privileges to operate on local VHF and UHF repeaters and limited privileges on some shortwave bands. It gives you access to the assistance of local hams with regards to station setup, antenna and other equipment issues. Amateur radio is a hobby and a public service that involves life-long learning. Most of us have learned about various aspects of the hobby from each other.



1. All sessions will be held at Frazer Church.
2. Normal class hours are from 6:00 PM until 8:30 PM on 8 consecutive Thursdays with exam the week following the last class.
3. Ten-minute breaks at 7 PM and 8 PM.
4. Class member expectations/responsibilities will be covered in the first module.
5. Tuition (\$40) includes the study manual, administration supplies and break drinks/snacks.
6. Amateur Radio Technician Exams will be scheduled at the end of the course. Class members are responsible for obtaining their Federal Registration Number from the FCC prior to the test session. The testing fee is not included in the tuition price.
7. There is an optional (no additional charge) “New Operators Class” that will cover basic operational procedures, net operations, specific antennas, etc. This class is scheduled for the two weeks following the testing session.
