The Montgomery Hamfest Nov 9, 2024

Hamfests across the country are seeing fewer vendors and visitors. We were worried about how we would do. It turns out that we tripled our profit from prior years and did very well! With that information, we quickly got with the Alcazar Shrine folks and paid for our reservation of the facility for our 2025 hamfest on November 8, 2025. They gave us the venue at the same price as this year.

There were a few empty tables. The historical radio association reserved a bunch of tables but did not show up. Nobody knows why. However, we were almost sold out on tables, so we did not see a big decline in demand for tables. Tower Electronics and The Sign Man both said that they did not do as well

So, all in all, a grand success, and we will do it again in 2025!
