We are looking for a dynamic, motivated and hardworking person to join our small team to support with:

This will be achieved through relationship-building with businesses and organisations within the Cairngorms National Park area and beyond.

This new fixed-term role involves a combination of desk-based, phone and in-person outreach to explore opportunities. It involves pro-active enquiry, lead generation and sales conversion, and informal and formal exploratory meetings (in person and/or online) to identify and convert new sales leads into paid memberships and advertising bookings.

The role will also assist in establishing new relationships with like-minded organisations who may be interested in collaborations for future events and projects, as part of Somewhere's thriving eco-system.

#### Community development and relationship building

- Making initial steps in engaging and connecting with a broad spectrum of businesses in the Park (and beyond) to begin new relationships and partnerships, supporting local community development
- Engaging with local groups, community associations and community gatekeepers to build trust and make new connections specifically with LGBTQ+ owned businesses
- Engaging with LGBTQ+ friendly businesses in the Park (and beyond), enabling new relationships and the potential for future partnerships and collaborations.
