It is more than education. It is hope. It is stability. It is a reminder to each child that they are seen, loved, and not forgotten.



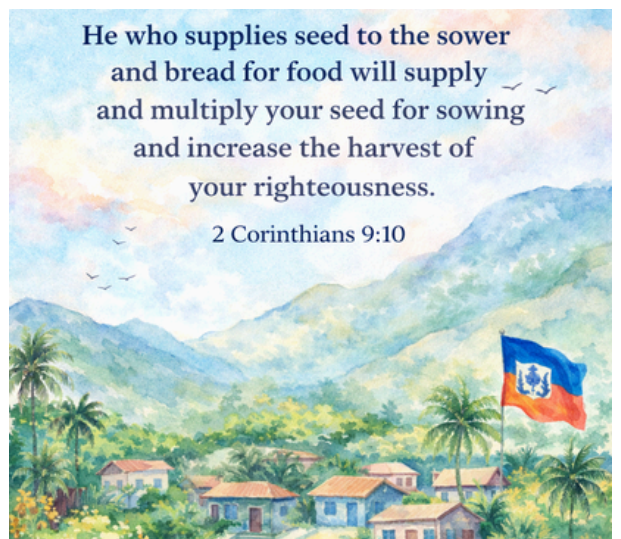
## Haiti Ministry Update – Supply and Multiply
