An Update for Year End 2018

Supply and Multiply is entering into its fifth year of being a ministry! We are excited for what the future holds. The ministry has grown from a little seed and has been blessed by God and grown more than we could have ever dreamed! Thank you for sowing your seed, watering the seeds that were planted, and rejoicing with us as we harvest many fruits!

As we look forward to 2019, we would ask for you to prayerfully continue your partnership with Supply and Multiply. Currently, we care for 9



residents full time at the Matthew 25 Houses, our elderly care facilities. In addition, we provide supplemental care to numerous elderly who live in their own homes. This includes food, medicine, and home repairs. We

have 19 staff members who receive regular monthly salaries and medical care. In addition, those with school aged children receive their education paid for as a blessing.

This school year, we have 70 students who are sponsored for school! 9 of those students are in advanced vocational school or university. The sponsorships create employment with the people who sell fabric, books, tailors, and teachers AND ensures those students, through education, have a literate future.

We have weekly Bible Clubs for children, “JAM CLUB”, short for Jezi ak Mwen or Jesus and Me. These take place in several locations throughout the

week. Children come to learn about Christ with songs, games, crafts, and Bible Stories. We are active with door to door evangelism as well. We sponsor a young adult program and a girls’ crochet group at one of the churches we are in relationship with. In addition, we assist both churches with projects such as prison outreach, teaching/Bible resources, repairs, music equipment, and special needs as they come up with church members.

Supply and Multiply has a program called Faith Farms Haiti where we continue to support and create ways to increase the food sources in Haiti. We currently have rabbits, chickens, and various rotating crops. We have recently invested into a water pump to assist in the bringing of water from



the river to the crops in the Fishing Village.

This year, in partnership with One Heart 2 Homes, we have completed 5 house builds in the community! One Heart 2 Homes provides the lion share of the financial resources for home builds.

In addition to our heartbeat ministries, we also host teams and provide numerous resources to the city such as teacher and pastor training, medical clinics, hygiene kits and practical items such as infant formula, food assistance with severe malnutrition, beds, and many other practical solutions to serve the community. All of this ministry takes places every day of the year and can only continue with your prayers and financial support.

Moving Into 2019

We desire to end the year financially on track and to be able to provide our employees with a thirteenth month of pay. In accordance with Haitian Government Labor Laws, this thirteenth month pay is a bonus month of pay that is paid to employees who have worked for us for at least twelve months. It is our desire to keep with the highest level of employment standards. We have been able to pay this blessing every year. However, this year due to the growth of the staff and the ongoing expenses for increased ministry, we need your help to meet this commitment. In addition, we have a few repair needs on our buildings and vehicles.
