



## What we do?

The heartbeat of Supply and Multiply is elderly compassion care. We believe that God's word compels us not just spread the Good News, but to also live His words in action.

Matthew 25:35-36, "For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me." Matthew 28:19, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

We have two elderly care residential care facilities, one for men and one for women, Matthew 25 Homes. The residents receive 24 hour a day, 7 days a week care. We ensure that they are cared for with respect and dignity until they take their final breath. When they pass from this life to the next they receive a complete funeral and burial.

In addition, we have elderly that live in their own homes independently that receive subsistence care such as food, safe housing, beds, and medical care.

Our ministry of elderly care allows us to employ Haitian Staff. We have a staff at any given time of over 15 people, sometimes as many as 20. Our staff give many hours of themselves to love and care for the elderly. In addition to their regular pay, the employees also receive school sponsorship for each of their kids.

The School Sponsorship program has 64 kids in the program for the 2018-2019 school year. Many of those students are staff members children, belong to the local churches we have relationships with, or are kids in the community with specific needs that were brought to our attention.

We have weekly JAM Clubs (Jesus and Me / Jezi ak Mwen). These are our childhood evangelism program. They are clubs that meet several times a week at various locations.

We have close relationships with two local churches. We assist them with projects and supplies to better equip their ministries. For example, music instruments, Bibles, and repairs. We also, have two staff members, one an Associate Pastor and one a Young Adult / Choir Leader.

A partnership with One Heart 2 Homes allows us to build families new homes! Some homes need new roofs, doors, beds, and we are able to complete those projects too. We also have individuals and businesses with a heart for safe housing that assist us on these projects.

Faith Farms is our agricultural program in Haiti. Our aim is to increase the food supply. We currently have fields of crops, chickens, and rabbits. In addition, we have installed a water pump system to provide water to the Fishing Village from the river. We also support Fisherman with supplies and boats.

We also serve the community in many ways such as hosting medical clinics, blessing families with food, support the local churches to do prison visits, and are always alert to what God doing and how we can participate.
