

Update on the Conditions in Haiti

The situation in Montrouis, Haiti, continues to be deeply challenging. Persistent political unrest, widespread gang violence, and severe economic instability have created a volatile and unsafe environment. Travel to the area has become increasingly dangerous, making it impossible for mission teams to visit and provide hands-on support. These conditions have not only disrupted our ability to engage in mission trips but have also significantly impacted the lives of those in the community.

Despite these challenges, the needs in Montrouis remain profound. Families struggle to access basic necessities such as food, clean water, and education. Many students face uncertainty regarding their future, as the rising cost of school fees and uniforms becomes insurmountable for their families. Vulnerable populations, including the elderly residents of the Matthew 25 House, are in desperate need of consistent support to meet their daily needs.

In response, we remain steadfast in our commitment to serve this community. We are focused on continuing to provide essential food supplies to the Matthew 25 House and to other families in the area who depend on this assistance. Additionally, we aim to ensure that students in Montrouis have the resources they need by covering school fees and providing uniforms, enabling them to pursue their education despite the ongoing crisis.

While the inability to travel limits our direct engagement, our work continues through dedicated local partners and your generous support. Together, we can bring hope and tangible help to those who need it most during this challenging time.

Snapshot of 2024 Ministry













- Mission Team to Poland to serve the Ukraine Refugees.
- 3 Mission Teams to Honduras
- Medical Clinic and Community Evangelism in Honduras.
- 11 Refugees were supported in their transition through immigration paperwork, job skills, housing, and education.
- Supported more than 100 students with school tuition, books, uniforms, and school supplies.
- Provide 24/7 care for 8 elderly and disabled in Haiti at the Matthew 25 house.
- Assisted families in Haiti with three funerals.
- Developed a relationship to be able to conduct seminars and share Christ with women in the snares of the sex industry.
- Distributed 192 Bibles.
- Blessed families in Haiti with food supplements.
- Rented homes in Haiti for 11 families.




Financial Overview

Financial Explanation



This year, our expenditures exceeded our income by \$17,030.08. We praise God that we had financial reserves from the previous year, and we were able to cover this shortfall. We closed the year with \$21,811.24 in cash assets.

Several factors contributed to the reduction in income. The global economic climate has presented challenges, and the ongoing instability in Haiti has prevented mission travel to the region. Mission teams have historically been a significant source of both income and networking opportunities for our ministry. Despite these challenges, we remain committed to our mission and are actively exploring new strategies to adapt and continue serving effectively.

Mission and Purpose
