We work closely with local partners, including churches, schools, and community leaders, to identify individuals with a high level of food insecurity. The aim is to provide meal supplements to children, families, and individuals who are most in need and most vulnerable. The individuals that Supply and Multiply assist are usually widows/ers, orphans and disabled people.

This is an adjustment for the host family and the individual who left their entire life behind to seek safety and opportunity. Pray about how God can use you in their lives.
