### Matthew 25 House



This year we completed the construction of the new Matthew 25 House. This was a work in progress over the past 2 years. It has been a pure delight to see all the elderly in one location and this allows us to consolidate our resources for maintenance and upkeep. We ended the year with 11 residents that live with us and receive full time care. Two of our residents are not elderly. God led these vulnerable and medically fragile residents into our care. This year we mourned the passing from this world to the next of Nerner in June.

### JAM Club



We started 2020 strong with JAM Clubs, young adult programs, and church leadership seminars. A key part of the Supply and Multiply evangelism mission strategy, focuses on earning trusting by meeting practical and compassion needs. We preach from a stage of earned authentic trust. Then we share the Good News through being a living witness, direct evangelism, and discipleship!

### Galatians 6:2



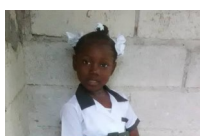
This year, more than ever, we carried the burdens of our brothers and sisters in Christ. We were able to host several medical clinics early in 2020. We were able to bless 15 individuals/families with housing rentals to increase their housing stability and security. We covered the cost of three funerals in addition to our Matthew 25 House resident. We paid for two major surgeries. We were able to provide supplemental food to hundreds of families. 18 individuals/families receive these blessings monthly to increase their food stability.

### Home Builds



This year we built 2 homes and completed construction on two other homes. In addition, we completed the construction of the Matthew 25 House to include windows and solar electricity system. We also repaired/replaced two roofs and provided beds for four families.

### School Sponsorship



For the 2020/21 school year we have 85 students in our sponsorship program. The students range in grades preschool through vocational and university level. The students missed several months of school early in the year due to their closure as they learned about Covid-19 and implement practices to prevent the spread. When school resumed they went on a modified schedule to catch up the lost months. The students are excelling in their programs.
