We provide rice, oil, and beans to most families. In addition, we supplement with items such as bananas, mangos, and papaya from our ministry gardens.

Wendy was playing basketball and ran into the backboard post. He broke his front tooth. It requires Endodontist dentistry and a cap. This repair is not just cosmetic, it is very painful and at risk for infection or damage to his other teeth. The estimate is around \$500 with money transfer and exchange rates.



One of our homebound elderly, Cherivil, whom many of you know as "Jo Jo" has went home to be with the Lord. Cherivil was such a hard worker you would often find him with his cane sitting next to a pile of rocks that he was hammering away on. We would encourage him to rest and he would tell us it was good to keep working. He had a gentle spirit and loved the Lord. We are blessed that the ministry provided him with food, home repairs, cane, walker, bed, and many other tangible provisions, but most importantly, shared the love and compassion of Jesus Christ. The family has asked if we can assist with \$350 towards the cost of his funeral.
