Greetings!

As we enter into the fall season and begin to wind down 2020, we want to thank you for having walked along side us during this challenging and unique year. We have seen God grace and mercy on display and He has surrounded us with wisdom and peace.

God has entrusted us with precious saintly senior souls for 24 hour care. We were recently able to move all of them into their new home! Students have returned to school or have plans to do so. We have increased our Galatians 6:2 ministry efforts during this season to meet the needs of those suffering great instability. We have replanted agricultural lands destroyed by storms. The two churches we are in relationship with have resumed worship. We have kept our eyes on Christ and have been able to see him every step of the way.

Many of you have asked about Gary and his children. They are pressing through this tough season. The children have come to terms with the fact that their mother is in Heaven. The youngest son struggled understanding the permanent nature of her earth death. Marie Daniel's nephews that she cared for continue to live with Gary. He is now a single father of five and he gives God all the glory that he is being carried through the dark valleys. He is filled with hope and daily shares his appreciation for the Supply and Multiply family.

One current struggle that has greatly disrupted our budget has been the instability in the Haitian Government and specifically in regards to their currency. The current exchange rate has changed from an average of 92-100 Haitian gourde to 1 US dollar to 72-60 Haitian gourde to 1 US dollar. However, this is not the "official" exchange rate so every bank and business are different. It also is not based on a rational inflation or service/good rate. For example, typically for \$35 a month we can provide a family with a sack of beans, rice, and oil. If a sack of rice averages 1800 gourde for a bag of rice at a exchange rate of 65 you are paying \$27.69 US dollars. Just two weeks ago that same sack of rice cost \$18.95. That is an increase cost of \$8.74. When you multiple that by our average month's use of 25 sacks for the Galatians 6:2 ministry and Matthew 25 House food, that is an increase of \$218.50. That is only for rice!

We need you to continue this work. If you are a current donor or supporting church, please prayerfully continue that support. If you have never given or feel called to give to a specific need, there is no better time then now. There is a great need to continue bringing the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We do this by proclaiming His truths and by sharing His love and compassion.

Here are some specific ways that you can financial help Supply and Multiply:

- ◆ We have had to preform an increased level of maintenance on the ministry vehicles the past few months. Some of this was broken parts and other services routine maintenance. Some of the items we have had to replace/service are an oil pump, rotors and brake pads, steering column shifter, and horn. These repairs cost us in excessive of \$700 with shipping and labor.
- ◆ We had several strong rains that have come through Monwi and we have had to adjust the windows in the new Matthew 25 House. This is a \$2400 expense. We are blessed to say that Harvest Bible has donated \$1000 to meet this need. We will begin work with that \$1000 and need to raise \$1400 to complete this project.



The Matthew 25 House is our residential care facility, the elderly live with us there and the staff makes it their mission to love and serve them with the love and compassion of Christ. Caring for the elderly and meeting their unique needs is expensive. They receive regular medical care and medications and physical therapy. These are in addition to their ongoing basic needs of food, clothing, and shelter. We also assume the responsibility of their end of life care and final resting. There are many variables in the cost to run the Matthew 25 House and through our recent consolidation to one house and reducing expenses we budget \$4000 monthly. This amount is for the elderly that are entrusted to our full time care.

The ministry of delivering food subsidies to elderly, widows/ers, orphanages, disabled, and other members are our community continues monthly. Those receiving the food are thankful for this program. Our Director Gary is able to be in the lives of these individuals and families allowing us to bring the compassion of Christ and be involved in their time of need.

Many schools have started school or have plans to start soon! We look forward to some activities as a ministry with our school students towards the end of October. After those gatherings we will get photos out to our sponsors. Thank you for your faithful sponsorship and for your patience as we have navigated this season.

Faith Farms

After a few hard storms, we have had to replant and clean up a lot of our large gardens and agricultural lands. The river water pump watering system is working great. We are able to provide water to the Fishing Village so that families can water their crops. We currently have two pumps sending water via aqueducts.
