We were able to bless people with various items from barber shears to medicine to ease a little bit of their burdens. We laughed, we cried, we grew in our dependence of God, and we pray that we shared the light of Christ to those we served!

Shear has had multiple surgeries and due to the difficult nature of Haiti and until recently he was unable to receive regular care. He is currently being fit for a HKAFO (hip knee ankle foot orthopedic). He is working on his strength. He has some contractures (tightening of the muscles) which are challenging to work with and may require more surgeries. We are prayerful that this therapy will make a difference in his life. As the gang activity in Haiti continues to take control of the roads, the need for the ministry to get food supplies and fuel in alternative methods. The boat can safely travel the coast when vehicles cannot be on the roads. In addition, due to the various ecological disasters in Haiti to obtain better fishing opportunities it is necessary to go further out in the ocean.

In addition to the purchase of the motor, we will have to ship it to Haiti. The cost of shipping is largely dependent on weight, so we do not have an exact amount currently.
