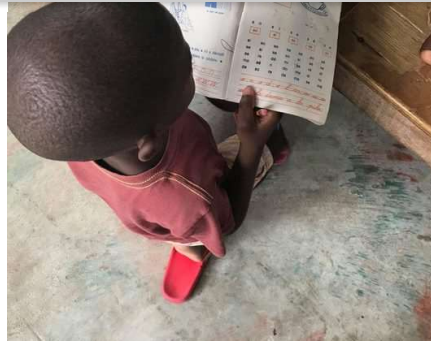
We are always Christ-Centered, Compassion-Driven, and Community-Focused!
