A ministry update from Audrey & Sebastian - July 31, 2026

What a joy it has been to witness God at work here in Honduras! This past week was extra special for our family - it was William's very first official mission trip!

Between balancing his nap schedule, driving the team bus (go, Sebastian!), and making sweet new friends, our hearts are overflowing. We were so deeply blessed to serve alongside our long-time partners, **Supply and Multiply (SAM)**, who have been faithful "boots on the ground" teammates with us since 2023.

Hitting the Ground Running

The moment SAM touched down, we jumped straight into action - heading directly from the airport into ministry in Castro 2. Throughout the week, their joy and tirelessness were a massive encouragement to our spirits. Whether hosting events at our building, serving alongside us in Sunseri, or treating the Sunseri kids to a fun day at the Children's Museum in San Pedro Sula, SAM brought so much light and relief to our ongoing work at House of Hope.

Bringing Hope to Unión y Esperanza

One of the sweetest highlights of the week was visiting Unión y Esperanza ("Union and Hope") - a community built for hurricane survivors and young people who grew up in local orphanages.

Our main heart for this community is simple: to bring the truth and hope of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

We hosted a dynamic VBS-style program full of energy, games, and direct Gospel teaching for the local kids and teens. Afterwards, our team had the privilege of serving a hot lunch to the 400 people who live in the entire community. Seeing hundreds of neighbors gathered together to be fed physically and spiritually was a beautiful picture of Christ's love in action.
