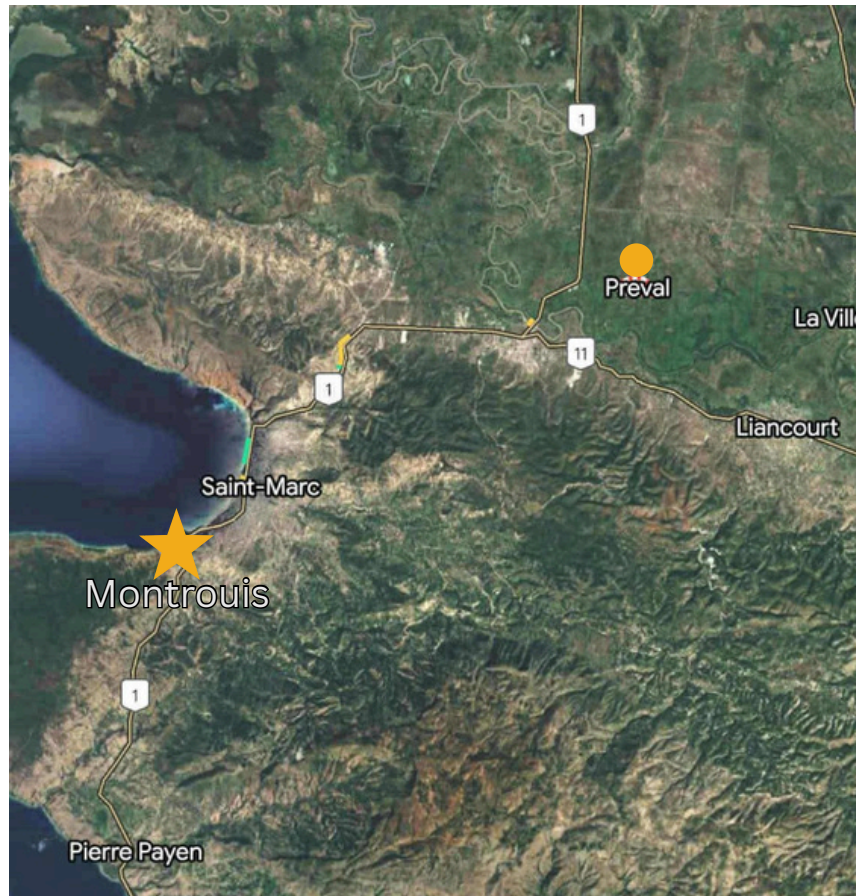




This is not some far-off land.



This is a map of Haiti. That small dot marked Préval is just a short drive from Montrouis, the location of the Matthew 25 House. It is as close to us as your local Walmart might be to your home.

According to a recent Miami Herald report, gangs have overtaken entire regions near Saint-Marc. This is the very same area staff drive through to get food. The same roads taken to transport elderly residents for medical care. The same path children wander.

The article is gut-wrenching. Women and children are being hunted and slaughtered. Families are fleeing with nothing, while entire communities are being burned to the ground. These aren't just headlines — these are real lives, many of whom have walked the very roads our own Haitian ministry family travels daily. This is terror, not tragedy from a distance. It's evil up close.

This is not just instability. This is collapse.

And yet... our team is still there. Still serving. Still feeding. Still caring. At the Matthew 25 House, we provide residential care for the elderly who would otherwise be abandoned. As resources allow, we bless people with food — because people are showing up at our gates desperate, afraid, and hungry.

This isn't a crisis unfolding on the other side of the world — it's unfolding on our doorstep. The danger is real. The need is overwhelming. And the call to act is now.

Galatians 6:2 tells us, "Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ." That's not a suggestion. It's a calling. There is no divorce between the Great Commission and the Great Commandment — they are two sides of the same coin.

Preach Jesus. Feed the hungry. That's what we're doing. Will you do it with us? We need your prayers. We need your financial support.
