

SONORA OUTFITTERS PACKING LIST AND INFORMATION

- Valid Passport (Required).
- 1 Pair of well broken-in hiking/ hunting boots.
- Day pack, Gear Bag or Backpack to carry belongings during the day.
- Light Rain Gear.
- Camera or Cellphone.
- Binoculars (only one pair of binoculars are permitted in Mexico).
- Rangefinder (optional).
- Flashlight or Headlamp with fresh batteries.
- Warm Jacket; Dress in layers, mornings can be cool and afternoons warm.
- Gloves, one lightweight pair.
- Cap and light stocking hat to keep ears warm.
- 2-3 pair of pants, including one heavier pair and a couple lightweight pairs.
- Base Layers, 5 pairs of underwear, 2-4 shirts, 5 pairs of socks.
- Personal Hygiene Kit, Wet Wipes, Washcloth, Toothbrush, Chap Stick, Sunscreen, Lotion, Razor, Body Soap, No Scent Deodorant.
- Prescription Medications and basic over-the-counter medications; Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Vitamins, Cough Drops, Airborne, etc.
- Loafing shoes or sneakers for around camp.
- Sunglasses, tissues, or eye drops for dry or wind-burned eyes.
- Gun Permit
 - Firearm permits for personal rifles require advance permitting and processing.
 - Please plan ahead if bringing your own firearm.
 - Ammunition should remain in original factory packaging during travel.
 - Soft rifle cases are recommended for use during daily ranch transportation.
- Outfitter Rifles are available upon prior arrangement.
- Cell service may be limited depending on ranch location. Please contact your carrier regarding international coverage.
- Tips and harvest fees are not included in hunt pricing. Please budget accordingly and plan to bring cash or check for gratuities and applicable harvest fees.
- Allergies or Medical Conditions; Hunters with severe allergies or medical conditions should notify outfitter prior to travel.
- Please pack all belongings in a **carry on suitcase and a backpack or handbag**. This **helps reduce the possibilities of your belongings not arriving** for your hunt. If you must check on luggage, please try to keep it as small as possible. **Most hunters can easily fit this list in a carry on and a small backpack or handbag.**

Travel Day Expectations

Upon arrival in Hermosillo, proceed through Mexican customs, then baggage claim if you checked a bag. Once cleared into Mexico, **Sonora Outfitters staff will meet you outside the airport terminal**. If bringing a firearm, declare it after you pick it up and present paperwork to the Mexican officers. Most hunters arrive with only carry-on luggage to reduce delays and lost baggage. Please notify your bank and credit card providers of international travel before departure. Keep your passport and travel documents accessible during travel.

This is an additional list of what you are allowed to legally bring with you on your trip to Mexico. The following items are generally accepted as personal use items for travelers entering Mexico under a tourist visa. If you bring more than what is listed, you may be required to pay a duty on arrival at the airport. **We strongly suggest keeping within the limits of your allowable items.** Travelers entering Mexico must comply with all Mexican customs and entry regulations.

Mexico Duty-Free Personal Items: Travelers entering Mexico can bring the following items **for personal use, without paying duty:**

Personal & Travel Items

- Clothing and footwear for your trip
- Personal hygiene items (toiletries, medications)
- Suitcase, backpack, and limited travel gear

Required Travel Documents

- Valid Passport
- Airline Ticket/Itinerary
- Mexican Firearm Permit (if applicable)

Electronics & Gear

- 1 cell phone
- 1 camera or video camera
- 1 GPS device
- Chargers and accessories

Hunting-Related (Non-Firearm)

- Hunting clothing and boots
- 1 pair of Binoculars and 1 Rangefinder
- Day pack / gear bag

Medications

- Prescription medications (in original packaging recommended)
- Basic over-the-counter meds

Important Restrictions

- **Only ONE pair of binoculars is allowed tax free**
- Firearms require a **pre-approved Mexican Gun Permit**
- Ammunition is strictly regulated
- Drones are not allowed without special permission
- Avoid bringing excess or duplicate gear (can trigger duty charges)

Pro Tips

- Keep gear **simple and clearly for personal use**
- Pack light—**carry-on preferred**
- Do NOT bring anything you don't absolutely need
- If you're unsure about an item, **ask us before traveling**
