

FLORIDA CONCEALED CARRY APPLICATION PROCESS

Illinois residents can apply for a Florida Concealed Carry permit without taking additional classes. You will need to follow the instructions below. **The extra hours/class required for a UTAH permit is not worth the money or time because it only adds one additional state which is Washington (not Washington, DC). See the attached chart.**

- FINGERPRINTS: The law requires you to submit a COMPLETE AND LEGIBLE SET OF PRINTS.

Ink Fingerprints must be taken by a Law Enforcement Agency (see below)

- PHOTOGRAPH: You must also submit a PASSPORT-TYPE COLOR PHOTOGRAPH.
- FEES: The total fee for the Florida Concealed Weapon or Firearm License is \$97.

This total consists of two separate fees: License Fee: \$55 and Fingerprint Processing Fee: \$42

Fees must be paid with a check or money order made payable to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Do not send cash. The Department will assume no liability for cash sent through the mail. Fees are nonrefundable and nontransferable

ILLINOIS RESIDENTS:

Suburban residents: Your local suburban police department will fingerprint you. You need **INK FINGERPRINTS (NOT LIVESCAN)**. They will not provide assistance with the application. You will have to complete the application on your own. You may want to go to Pelcher's (see below)

City of Chicago residents: CPD will not complete ink fingerprints for this process.

You can go to Pelcher's Gun Range to get your ink fingerprints completed as well as application assistance. The owner of Pelcher's Gun Range can certify your prints. Pelcher's charge is \$50 for the ink fingerprints, photo and application assistance. Pelcher's will also provide the Florida application. **YOU MUST BRING YOUR CONCEALED CARRY QUALIFICATION CERTIFICATE AND A PHOTO ID.**
