

Working Smoke Alarms Save Lives

DO YOURS WORK?

Approximately 80% of home fire deaths in Oregon, happen in homes where working smoke alarms are not present.

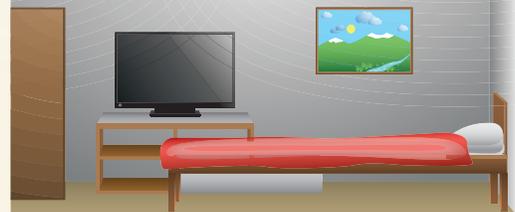


Test alarms at least once a month by pressing the test button.



Install smoke alarms

inside bedrooms, in the sleeping areas outside of bedrooms, and on every level of the home.



If you rent, and do not have working smoke alarms, contact your landlord.



Replace all smoke alarms that are **10 YRS OLD OR OLDER.**



DO NOT remove batteries for nuisance alarms.

Push hush button to temporarily silence alarm.



Working smoke alarms provide early warning, giving you more time to escape, and cut the risk of dying in a home fire in half.
