Day 1: Outdoor Adventures & Local Eats

Morning



Breakfast at The Hub - Social Good Brews

Start your day with locally roasted coffee and a fresh pastry or breakfast sandwich at this cozy café that supports community initiatives.



Eisenbahn State Trail

Hop on a bike or take a scenic walk along this beautiful rail-trail, which stretches through the countryside and connects you to stunning views of the Milwaukee River. If you're into longer rides, head north toward Kewaskum for a peaceful, rural adventure.

Lunch at Riverside Brewery & Restaurant

Enjoy a handcrafted beer and a delicious meal on their patio overlooking the Milwaukee River. Try the beer cheese soup or the fish tacos!

Kayaking on the Milwaukee River

Rent a kayak or bring your own and paddle down the serene waters of the Milwaukee River. The gentle current makes for a relaxing yet scenic trip through West Bend's lush landscapes.



Explore Lac Lawrann Conservancy

This 137-acre nature preserve is perfect for a quiet hike through wetlands, woodlands, and prairie. Keep an eye out for native birds and wildlife!

Evening



Dinner at Timmer's Resort

Nestled along Big Cedar Lake, this historic lodge offers fine dining with lakefront views. The walleye and prime rib are local favorites!



Wrap up your day with a show at this beautifully restored 1929 theater, offering live music, comedy, and classic film screenings.

Day 2: Arts, Culture & Local History

Morning

Breakfast at Toucan Food & Custard

A local favorite known for hearty breakfast platters and delicious custard-based shakes.

Museum of Wisconsin Art (MOWA)

Immerse yourself in the rich artistic heritage of Wisconsin at this modern museum showcasing works from local and regional artists. The rotating exhibits make every visit unique!

Lunch at The Norbert

This trendy farm-to-table spot in a historic downtown building offers creative small plates and craft cocktails.


III Explore Downtown West Bend & History Highlights

Breakfast at Cafe Floriana

After the market, stop by this charming café for a flaky croissant, a specialty latte, or a hearty breakfast sandwich.

Lunch at Maricio's in Barton

This cozy Italian spot offers fantastic wood-fired pizzas and homemade pasta dishes in the historic Barton district.

Explore Glacial Blue Hills Recreation Area & Ice Age Trail Segment

Take a final nature escape with a peaceful hike through this forested park, which features scenic bridges, wildlife, and a section of the famous Ice Age Trail.
