Educational Psychologists (EPs) work with children and young people (CYP), their families, and schools.

EPs support CYP who may experience difficulties with the following needs:

- learning skills
- communication and interaction skills
- social skills
- emotional literacy skills
- emotional regulation skills
- behaviour
- sensory regulation
- psychological development
