001	Licence to be carried in vehicle at all times.
003	Daylight use only.
010	450 mm square red flags to be placed at 4 extremities.
011	To be preceded by a pilot vehicle bearing signs.
012	To be preceded & followed by pilot vehicles bearing signs.
021	Not to travel within 30 km of GPO Perth during peak hour periods. Mon-Fri 7.30 am-9.00 am, 4.30 pm-6.00 pm.
024	Movement in accordance with Main Roads WA permit or notice
037	Speed limit 35 km/h.
153	OVERSIZE sign displayed as required. Sign must be at least 1020 mm long x at least 250 mm high, black letters at least 180 mm high (per A1744) on reflective yellow background (per AS/NZS1906).
172	Where the vehicle is used during hours of darkness it must be fitted with appropriate lighting.

PLEASE NOTE: If the vehicle is used on a road contrary to the conditions above, the vehicle licence will be deemed invalid under section 7(4) of the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Act 2012*. Motor Injury Insurance will not apply and penalties may be incurred.
