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Align Your Life with God's Will!

Scripture: Psalm 119:133 - Order my steps in thy word: and let not any iniquity have dominion over me.

People of God our prayers should consist in asking God to guide our steps according to His word and prevent sin from controlling our lives. Go to God and follow His instructions and guidance for every decision and action, recognizing that without divine help, sin could easily have power over us. Our ultimate desire is for us to conform to God's will, free from the dominion of iniquity.

This is also a desire for God's ongoing direction rather than relying on our own sense of right or wrong, or external influences. If we acknowledge that sin can become dominant if we do not actively resist it with God's help. However, God's word is the blueprint and standard for a righteous life. Because we cannot direct our own steps toward righteousness on our own power. We need divine assistance and grace to live a life pleasing to God. Therefore, the psalmist prayer reflects a yearning for perfect holiness, a desire to align every aspect of life with God's will.

God sees and knows all mankind's actions and thoughts and even counts every step we take (Omniscience). He provides a secure and stable path for His people, removing obstacles and ensuring our steps are firm and unhindered, symbolizing divine guidance, freedom from distress, and steadfastness in life's challenges. God's empowerment gives us stability and liberty to walk confidently in His will.

God's righteousness prepares the way for His blessings and guidance for His people, urging us to follow His perfectly timed steps and walk in the path of His will. It ensures us prosperity and faithful walk in accordance with His divine plan. If we follow wisdom, our life's path will be clear and unimpeded, allowing us to walk without hindrance and run without stumbling, leading to a successful life free from the hardships faced by fools (Proverbs 4:12).

Mankind can conceive and make plans for their lives; God is ultimately sovereign and directs the course of events and actions (Proverbs 16:9). So, we must trust in God's plan, even when our plans are disrupted or altered, because God's timing and outcomes are ultimately greater and better than our own.

People of God see the world as it is—physically decaying and spiritually infected with sin. But the children of God do not need to be pessimistic, for we have hope for future glory. We look forward to the new heaven and new earth God has promised, and we wait for God's new order that will free the world from sin, sickness, and evil. In the meantime, we go with Christ into the world where we heal people's bodies and souls and fight the evil effects of sin in the world.

Jesus frees us from the consequences of sin, from self-deception, and from deception by Satan. He is the source of truth, the perfect standard of what is right. Jesus himself is the truth that makes us free. He shows us clearly the way to eternal life with God. As we seek to serve God, Jesus' perfect truth frees us to be all that God meant us to be.

Through the Holy Spirit, God provides freedom from sin and condemnation (Romans 8:1). When we come to Christ to save us, He removes our heavy burden of trying to please Him and our guilt for failing to do so. By trusting Him we are loved, accepted, forgiven, and freed to live for Him.
