## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- Scorers, officials, and balls will be provided by the host school.
- Each school will provide one line judge for their own matches.
- There will be a hospitality room for coaches and officials.
- Admission will be charged \$5 adults and \$3 students. Over 65 and under 6 are free.
- Team trophies will be awarded to first and second place.

## **Play will be as follows:**

1. Round Robin two game matches in each pool will be played. 25 point (no cap) will be used in the pool play games. We will start at 6 pts.
2. Round Robin won-loss record will determine the winner and second place positions in each pool.
3. Round Robin two game matches in each pool will be played. 25 point (no cap) will be used in the pool play games. We will start at 6 pts.
4. Round Robin during round robin play for the teams involved in the tie.
5. If a tie continues to exist, a point differential between the teams involved in the tie will be used to determine the teams' positions.  
*Exception for 2<sup>nd</sup> place tie: a team will not be eliminated from participation in the semi-final matches due to point differential. A 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place team will play one 15 pt. rally game if still tied after (4) head-to-head competition in pool play.*
6. If a tie continues to exist for 1<sup>st</sup> place, a point differential for total tournament play will be used to determine the teams' positions.
7. If a tie still exists for 1<sup>st</sup> place, the tie will be broken with a coin flip.
8. Semi-final and final matches will be two out of three games.
