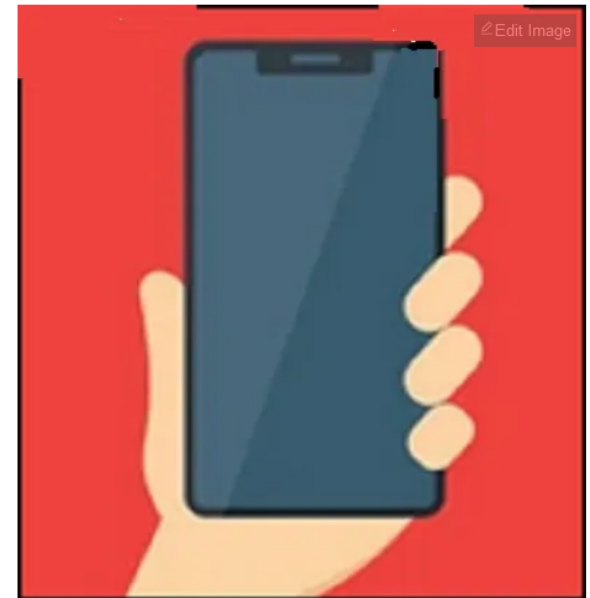

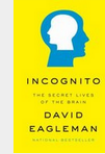

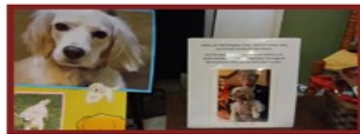
Rylee



Rylee is a Golden Retriever/Cocker Spaniel mix - about 26 pounds of pure sweetness!

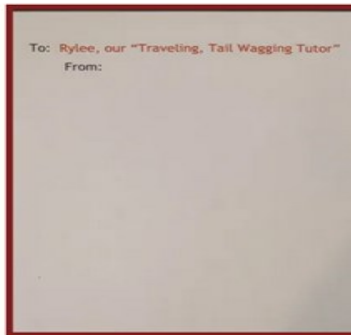
