OVERVIEW/INTRODUCTION

- ❖ Date and Place: 1688 B.C. Written while author was a sheepherder with Jethro
- **Author:** Moses, the law giver and leader of the nation of Israel.
- Theme: The creation, the fall, and redemption of the human race through Jesus Christ.
- **Purpose:** To reveal to man the origin of the creation and to reveal God who is the personal Creator of all things and to solicit man's wholehearted allegiance to God.
- ❖ Statistics: 1st book of the Bible, 50 chapters, 533 verses, 38,267 words, 1, 385 verses of history, 148 questions, 56 prophecies, 123 verses of unfulfilled prophecies, 106 commands, 71 promises, 326 predictions.

Introduction

The book of Genesis contains a beautiful account of how God created order out of chaos. The book points to God's sovereignty and power to create a world according to his wishes and plans. We see in Genesis that out of all the tings God created man and woman was at the top of all creation. We are going to see in this first lesson how God used the power of his spoken word to create most of the world; but when it came to man and woman, he used his hands to shape and mold them into existence. The book of Genesis is the foundation for the entire Bible. All other books of the Bible rests on the book of Genesis.
