LESSON 10

Know That The Holy Spirit Is Your Personal Compass

John 14:16,17,26; 16:7-13

INTRODUCTION

A compass is an instrument used for navigation and orientation that shows direction relative to the geographic cardinal directions (or points). Usually, a diagram called a compass rose shows the directions north, south, east, and west on the compass face as abbreviated initials. When the compass is used, the rose can be aligned with the corresponding geographic directions; for example, the "N" mark on the rose points northward. Compasses often display markings for angles in degrees in addition to (or sometime instead of) the rose. The compass is an indispensable tool in the survival kit for one who is lost or confused in each location. However, the compass is of no use unless one knows how to read it. One must be familiar with degrees and North, South, Eat, and West.

Likewise, we need a compass in life. We need a compass to show us which way to go in life. It appears that this world is becoming more and more like a jungle with wild animals (humans) lurking and dangers all around. We need a compass to guide us around the pitfalls. 
