LESSON 14

Know That After Death Comes The Resurrection Pt. 1

John 5:28-29, 1Cor. 15:19-28, Heb.9:27

INTRODUCTION

At the graveside of our friends and love-ones the minister will conduct a committal service and say, “Forasmuch as it has pleased Almighty God in His wise providence to take out of this world the soul and spirit of our deceased love one _____ we therefore commit his/her body to the ground, earth to earth, ashes to ashes dust to dust.” Over the years I have sadly recited those words hundreds of times. Sometimes I have cited them at the services of close friends and family members. It is a sad time to see your love ones depart. We live. We work. We play. We laugh. Then we die. The big question is; Is this all? If death is the end what is the use living for God? If death is the end what is the use doing good?

Although we do not know what is on the other side, we believe what the Bible says about it and look forward to making the transition. Jesus said in John 11:25-26, “I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die.” Job did not know the truths of the gospel of Christ. He lived before Christ came to earth; but Job had a hope of resurrection. Job said in Job 19:25-27, “For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth: And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God: Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another; though my reins be consumed within me.” In our lesson today we are going to take a close look at what happens when we die according to the Bible.

- B. The hope: “But now, Christ is risen from the dead
- C. Jesus has become first fruits of those who (slept) died. The Dead called, sleep. See also John 11:11
- D. Adam the first man brought death
- E. Jesus the second man brought resurrection by his resurrection

3rd Reading- 1 Corinthians 15:22-23.....Adam Brought Death But Jesus Brought Life

- A. Adam by sin brought death- See Romans 6:23
- B. Jesus brought life by his death, burial, and resurrection
- C. Every man in his order- God has an order in the resurrection (1st Resurrection & 2nd Resurrection) See Revelation 20:4-5 ***For more clarity more exposition is needed. Will be included in Part 2**
- D. Christ's the first-fruits of the dead. Jesus was the first to be raised to die no more.
- E. They that are Christ's (Believers) at his coming

4th Reading-1 Corinthians 15:24.....The Eternal Reign And Rule Of Christ

- A. Then cometh the end- The end of what? The world as we know it.
- B. Christ will deliver up the kingdom to God-Jesus:The conquering king
- C. *Even the Father-The First person of the Holy Trinity*

5th Reading- 1 Corinthians 15:25-26.....Jesus Will Reign By Conquering The Last Enemy-Death

- A. He must reign-he shall reign
