

INTRODUCTION

In the last two lessons we have discussed the resurrection of the body and some of the details of the Christian's resurrection. We said we will have brand new bodies that will not be subject to corruption or decay. We said that both the righteous and the wicked will be raised from the dead and consigned to heaven or hell.
