Genesis 6:1-22

God's Disappointment Leads To Judgment: The Flood

Introduction

God is Almighty. He is sovereign. He can do whatever he will and no one can call his hand. He is in absolute control of the universe. So far, as we have seen in our study, God made everything beautiful. He created a perfect world. The world and mankind were growing as God had planned; but it is also growing in wickedness. God has feelings. God feels joy, pleasure, pain, and disappointment. His feelings are associated with his love and care for mankind and his universe. God did not need mankind to be God. He is still God without man; but he wanted man to fellowship with. The wickedness of the world is weighing down heavy upon God, and not measuring up to his expectations. Since God is holy and just but also loving and kind; what will he do with such a wicked world? God determined that he will destroy the world but he would save a remnant-Noah and his family. On the one hand we will see judgment but on the other hand we will see grace and mercy.
