## Take Action:


- Talk to your coworkers and friends and others about how a rules-based international system has helped prevent another world war.




## Area Events

# Voting Timeline: 2026 Primary

**December 17**

**Apply for Vote By Mail**  
First day to apply for a vote by mail ballot for the 2026 General Primary Election

**January 2**

**UOCAVA Application**  
First day for persons outside the country to apply for Vote by Mail ballot

**February 5**

**Voting by Mail Begins**  
First day for the election authority to mail an official ballot

**February 18**

**Grace Period Registration and Voting Begins**  
First day of grace period registration and voting at the office of the election authority or at a location designated

**February 5**

**Early Voting Begins**  
First day for early voting at the office of the election authority and at any additional locations

**February 17**

**Close of Voter Registration**  
Last day for regular registration or transfer of registration

**March 1**

**Online Voter Registration Closes**  
Last day for online voter registration

**March 12**

**Last Day to Mail Vote by Mail Ballots**  
Last day for the election authority to receive, by mail, an application for a vote by mail ballot

**March 17**  
**General Primary Election**

## F.Y.I.

- Federal Seats:** In Stephenson County candidate include Incumbent Congressman Eric Sorensen in the 17<sup>th</sup> District (the southern part of our county and Paul Nolley in the 16<sup>th</sup> District (the northern part of the county) running against the incumbent Rep. LaHood.
- In addition US Senator Dick Durbin is not running again and there are MANY Democrats running for his seat. In the next few days and weeks, it will be clearer, who will be on our Primary ballots.
- State Seats:** All the State wide Offices are up for election. They include Governor, Comptroller, Treasurer, Secretary of State, and Attorney General
- County wide seats:** There are many seats up for election. We have Democrats running for County Board, none of them have an opponent in the March Primary.



The news is happening so fast, it's hard to keep up. Indivisible is calling for **"Ice Out for Good"** pop-up protests this weekend. We don't have any official planned protest in Freeport this weekend, but anyone can start one. You can also join the vigil in Rockford on Sunday or in Oregon today.
