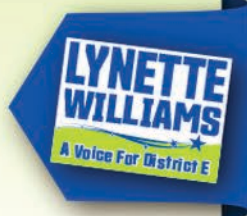
### **Transparency and Accountability**

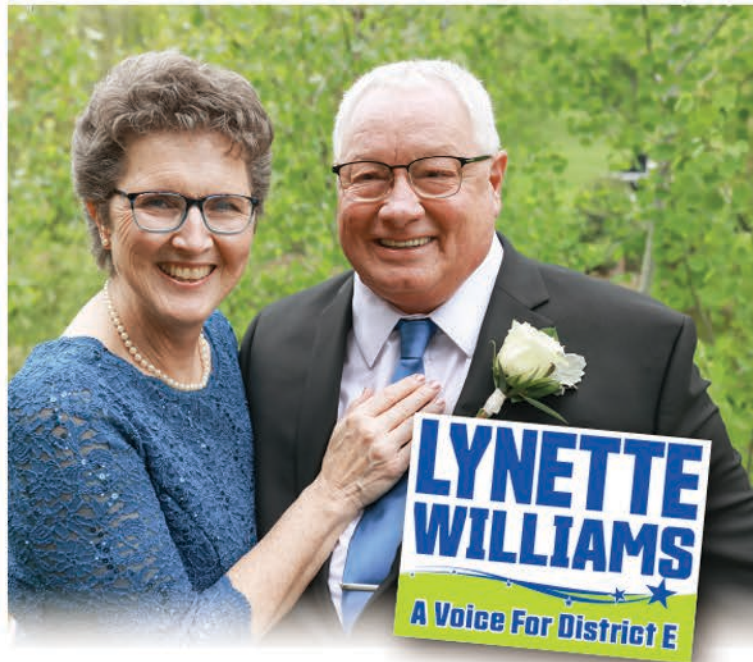
### **Mill Race Crossing**
