ANNA IS LEADING AND GETTING RESULTS, BY:

Fighting for our values

- → Anna implemented the City of Chicago's first Municipal ID program a government-issued ID, transit, library, business, and prescription discount card. This card provides access to services regardless of age, criminal record, housing status, or gender identity and offers a non-binary option, the first for any city in Illinois.
- → Anna launched the Fines, Fees, and Access collaborative which established major reforms in the city's fines and fees practices. This work strives to give working people an affordable pathway to compliance and creates racial and judicial equity in these practices.

Leading a new generation of women and girls

- → As the second Latina to serve as Clerk of the City Chicago, Anna created the Chicago Status of Women and Girls Working Group tasked with recommending citywide policies and initiatives to make Chicago a safer, more equitable place for women and girls.
- → As a millennial leader, in partnership with Chicago Public Schools, Anna launched NextGen City Council, a program providing high school students the opportunity to experience the law-making process by acting as city council members.

Creating access to government for working families

- → Digitizing city council meetings, committee meetings, and records
- → Modernizing the clerk's office operations by creating access to services outside 9/5 working hours
