While he was dying his executioners gambled for the only piece of property he had, his coat. When he was dead, he was taken down and laid in a borrowed grave.

All the armies that ever marched, All the navies that ever sailed And all the parliaments that ever sat And all the kings that ever reigned Put together have not affect the life of man Upon this earth As powerfully as this One Solitary Life.
