

Villager of the Year

The Villager of the Year program, sponsored by the Association, is designed to recognize individual residents or group of residents who exemplify, by their contribution of time and talent, what it means to be a Villager volunteer helping to create the 'Good Life in the Villages'. The program started in 1990. Any resident of the Villages has the opportunity to nominate a candidate(s) for Villager of the Year. In the Spring of each year the Board requests nominations for Villager of the Year, for the prior year, from all residents and selects a Committee of non Board members to receive the nominations. Sitting Board members are ineligible for nomination. The Committee then selects the Villager of the Year. The selected Villager of the Year is presented a plaque acknowledging their contributions at a Board Meeting in April. A plaque is also added to the Villager of the Year recognition wall in Lounge 1.
