There is a permission form for parents to fill in prior to the day in OWNA or at the service.



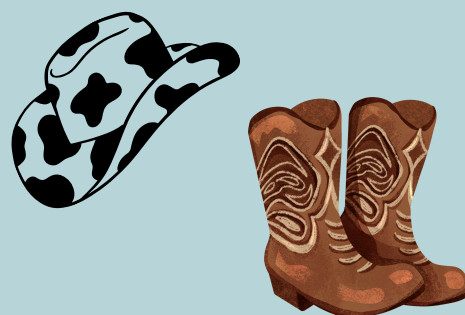
Wednesday 14th Jan- MAKAR SANKRANTI

Friday 16th Jan- THE BEST STORY EVER

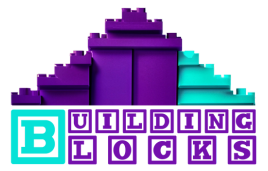

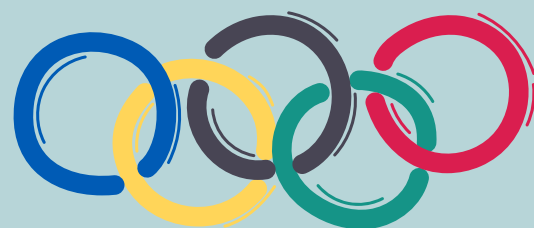
Wednesday 28th Jan- WILD WATER DAY

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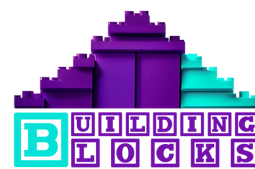


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Fees

Daily Fee: \$55 (includes breakfast, morning tea, afternoon tea and all activities)

Incursions: \$17 (cost of incursion activities)

Excursions: \$40 (covers entry, transportation, extra activities while at excursion)

All fees are CCS approved with CCS processed prior to fees being charged to families.

Families need to check their CCS details are correct prior to holiday care.

Hours of Operation

We are open from **6:30am** until **6:30pm** every day, excluding public holidays and closure periods. For days where excursions or incursions are scheduled, please drop off children by 9am unless otherwise specified.

Location

We are located in the school library for drop off and collection of children. Families will use the OSHC intercom button to drop off and collect children as all other gates are locked during holiday care.
