Hours of Operation

Please keep in mind we are a nut aware service so please refrain from packing foods that may contain nuts (including foods such as Nutella, chocolate bars, some muesli bars, etc.) Food that is found to contain nuts will be kept in your child's bag and a sandwich will be provided.

LOCATION

Our drop off and collection location is in the school library with access via the pedestrian gate at the front of the school.

The front gate is locked between 8:30am until 3:30pm to ensure that the school grounds are secure during the day. If you are bringing your children after 8:30am or collecting before 3:30pm, please call the service phone on 0434 114 557 when you arrive, and an educator will meet you at the gate to unlock it.

FEES

Daily fee: \$55 per day

IN (Incursion) fee: \$17 per incursion

EX (Excursion) fee: \$30 per excursion

All fees are CCS approved with CCS processed prior to gap fees being charged to families.

Prior to holiday care, families need to ensure that their CCS enrolment has been confirmed and that all billing details are up to date in OWNA.
