

RULES AND PROCEDURE

Rules are to be adhered to on the club grounds year round – the grounds are inclusive of both upstairs and on the beach. The rules are few and put in place for the protection of our members and their guests; every member and their guests are expected to adhere to these rules.

- Any person entering the grounds must have a button (except for those under the age of 10)
- Any vehicle entering the grounds must have either a sticker permanently affixed to the
 windshield or a 1 day or 3 day parking pass must be purchased and placed on the dashboard. All
 motorized vehicles will need a sticker, including golf carts and mules. A 7 day parking pass is
 available but must be purchased in advance by the member for themselves or their guest.
- Only non-glass containers are allowed on the grounds.
- No fireworks on the grounds.
- Dogs are allowed access on the grounds and to the beach from sunrise until 9:30AM daily. Dogs
 must be leashed on the grounds and owners must clean up after their dogs.
- No personal household garbage may be placed in the LMBPOA dumpster.
- Camping and bonfires both require permits which must be obtained in advance from a guard.
 Both camping and bonfires must be beyond the two orange poles to the North and South of the stairs. Other procedures that need to be followed for camping can be found on the permit.
- Rules for reserving the clubhouse will be supplied when a member places a reservation for a private member party.
- A member renting their home <u>may not</u> give their renters access to the club grounds. This is punishable by a fine or by revoking the owners membership.
