This free service ensures that our most vulnerable customers benefit from a dedicated service and receive priority assistance in the event of power disruption.

## READY WHEN YOU NEED US MOST

You can join our Priority Services Register if you:

- Are deaf or hard of hearing
- Have a disability
- Live with children under five
- Are blind or partially sighted
- Have a chronic illness
- Use medical equipment/aids reliant on electricity
- Are over 60

If you're unsure whether or not you qualify, contact us to discuss your circumstances.

## TIPS TO HELP YOU BE READY

If you know that adverse weather is on the way, or we've told you that we need to turn off your power to carry out planned maintenance, here are some tips for how you can prepare for a power cut:

- Keep a torch and batteries within easy reach
- Keep an analogue phone you can plug in handy (these can work without electricity but a lot of modern digital phones won't)
- Make sure your mobile phone is charged
- Keep a note of important numbers – including the 105 power cut number
